Cacti are known for surviving without much watering, as they retain water in their stems.

However, that doesn't mean they don't need watering at all. Be sure to check the soil every few weeks

Ensure that the right soil mix is used when potting cacti. Cacti prefer soil that includes more sand and rocks, in order to drain water and keep the plant dry between drinks and prevent root rot

You don't want to screech from a gnarly spiker from these plants. It is essential to wear protective gloves whenever you repot your cactus.
